

Who we are: Fondazione Banca dei Tessuti di Treviso (FBTV) procure, process, storage and distribute homologous tissues for transplant in humans. FBTV is located in Veneto Region, in the North of Italy.

Tissues managed by FBTV are cardiac homografts, vascular segments, amniotic membrane and osteo-tendinous tissues (bone and tendon). Tissues are procured from living and multi-tissue donors.

Another important task is promoting research and studies in the field of surgery and transplantation/implantation, also in partnership with Universities, International Institutes and Health Authorities.
